JULY 28, 2026

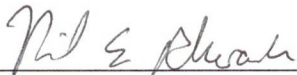

The purposes of the Special Meeting were to address an employment issue and plan for the renewal of the Township's Fire/EMS levy.

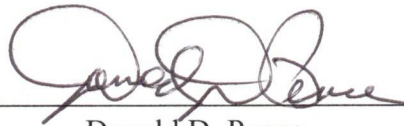

2. Fire/EMS Levy Renewal: The Trustees discussed the best methods for informing Concord Township residents about the levy renewal on the November 3, 2026 ballot.
